Prices and earnings during our senior year: what could we afford?

A new VW bug cost \$1,700, and the gas to fill it cost about 31¢ /gal. A McDonald's hamburger was about 18¢, a milkshake about 20¢. Minimum wage to pay for all this was about \$1.30/hr. For a young family in LA (38-yr old employed husband, wife not employed full-time, 8-yr-old girl and 13-yr-old boy), the total budget for a "moderate" living standard was about \$9,500/yr. Of this, \$1,400 was for rent, while homebuyers paid \$1,800/year; both included utilities and insurance. A dozen large eggs cost 49¢, down 10¢ from the year before. At Disneyland, the 1966 Junior (12 through 17) "Big 10" ticket book cost \$3.50/person. Images of Disneyland Grad Night '67 tickets show the 11pm-5am special evening of unlimited access to all rides & attractions cost \$8.00/person.
